## **Confirmation**

Dear Candidates for Confirmation, Parents, Guardians and Teachers.

Due to the very changed circumstances that have affected all our lives since the middle of March it has not been possible to administer the sacrament of confirmation in the Archdiocese.

Now the Archdiocese is working out the best way to confer the sacrament as soon as it is feasible. A group of priests, school personnel and parents are working on a plan to ensure the sacrament is administered in late summer or early autumn.
